Policy for Funding Energy Management Projects

Purpose:

Energy Management Funds may be used for the implementation of projects that will reduce energy usage and have a beneficial effect on the Purchased Utility Budget of Ohio University.

Submission of Proposals:

Proposals should be submitted to the Director of Energy Management. Proposals may be submitted from any source outlining the scope of the energy project with any supportive data that indicates potential avoidance of energy usage.

Criterion Used for Evaluating Projects:

1. Will the project reduce energy usage? Water is included in this category.
2. Will the project be of a continuing benefit?
3. Will the project have an adverse effect on any other energy use?
4. Will building occupants, programs or normal operations be adversely effected by the project?
5. Will the payback through energy cost avoidance be less than 5 years?
6. Will the project have an adverse effect on the environment?
7. Will the project comply with all federal, state, and local codes?
8. New ideas which have not had a proven beneficial result will be considered on an experimental basis.
9. Consideration will be given for partial funding for projects that show a portion of the project will reduce energy usage.
