January 2008

Online housing contract system activated.

February 2008

- FAFSA form should be submitted to ensure it reaches Ohio University by first priority date of March 15, 2008. File at www.fafsa.ed.gov.

May 2008

May 1

Freshmen Gateway Award recipients must submit their housing contracts (or exemption forms) and housing deposits on or before this date to receive their awards.

May 15

Transfer students must be admitted to be considered for scholarships.

May 21
